RE: North Marina Ameron/Hulbert Site – Satisfaction of Agreed Order No. DE 6677

Dear Mr. Reardanz:

On June 3, 2009, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology), the Port of Everett (Port), Ameron International Corporation (Ameron), and the Hulberts (collectively the potentially liable persons [PLPs]) entered into an Agreed Order (DE 6677). The Agreed Order required the PLPs to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) per WAC 173-340-350 and develop a draft Cleanup Action Plan (DCAP) per WAC 173-340-350 through 173-340-380 addressing both potential upland and in-water (i.e., adjacent marine sediment) contamination for the North Marina Ameron/Hulbert Site (Site).

To date, the PLPs have completed all of the elements required by the Agreed Order, which includes the following:

- Preparation of an Interim Remedial Action Report
- Development of a work plan to perform an RI/FS
- Conducting an RI/FS study
- Preparation of an RI/FS report
- Development of a draft cleanup action plan for the Site

Pursuant to paragraph IX, Ecology is providing the PLPs notice that it has satisfactorily completed the provisions of Agreed Order No. DE 6677. Implementation of the cleanup action plan for the Site will be conducted under a Consent Decree, which was filed with the Snohomish County Superior Court on January 16, 2015, cause number 15-2-01720-7.
