## Dear Trustees:

On September 4, 2015 the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the above-listed site.

The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on October 4, 2015.

Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at Temple Distributing/Carson Oil. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that Temple Family Survivor's Trust is a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to the Temple Distributing/Carson Oil Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, Mary Monahan, will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
