Air Quality Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer Permit, State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist and Determination of Non-Significance (DNS)

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) held 15-day and 30-day public comment periods from June 25 through July 10, 2015, and March 2 through 31, 2015, for documents related to the installation of a regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) at the Pasco Landfill NPL (National Priorities List) site. Documents for review and comment included the proposed Air Quality Permit and supporting information, the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist and Determination of Non-Significance (DNS). The 30-day comment period was for the permit and related documents, and the 15-day period was for the SEPA documents.

The purpose of this Response to Comments document is to provide Ecology's responses to comments submitted by the public during the comment periods.

No comments were received during either comment period. No changes will be required to the air quality permit, SEPA checklist, or DNS.
