Ecology has reviewed the Limited Site Investigation Report, Former ARCO Facility No. 00862, Manhole 34 Facility, ARCADIS, October 7, 2011. Based on our review of your comprehensive assessment, it is clear that factors unknown at time of entry of the Consent Decree exists and that the current cleanup action is **not effective** at protecting human health and the environment at this Site.

In accordance with the Site's Consent Decree, paragraph 76.b, Ecology is providing this written notice that **further remedial action is necessary** at the Site to protect human health and the environment.


