Thank you for submitting your Underground Storage Tank Site Assessment dated June 1991 for Department of Ecology (Ecology) review. Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing an independent remedial action under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the file for this site, which includes the following information, to determine if this site meets the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) cleanup standards:

1. Subsurface Environmental Investigation, International Paper Truck Shop, by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, dated September 20, 2001.
2. Response to Comments, International Paper Truck Shop, by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, dated October 25, 2001.

Based upon the file information which includes the above listed document Ecology has determined that the site does not pose a threat to human health or the environment as a result of the release addressed in the independent remedial action reports.

Therefore, Ecology is issuing this determination that no further action is necessary at this site under MTCA, Ch. 70.105D RCW. However, please note that because your actions were not, or will not be conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is not a settlement by the state under RCW 70.105D.040(4) and is not binding on Ecology.

This determination is made only with respect to the contamination identified in Subsurface Environmental Investigation, International Paper Truck Shop, by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, dated September 20, 2001.

This no further action determination applies only to the area of the property affected by the contamination identified in the Subsurface Environmental Investigation, dated September 20, 2001. This no further action determination does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by International Paper Co.

Ecology does not assume any liability for any release, threatened release or other conditions at the site, or for any actions taken or omitted by any person or his agents or employees with regard to the release, threatened release, or other conditions at the site.

Ecology will upgrade its database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. Klickitat District Truck Shop will not appear in future publications of the Confirmed & Suspected Contaminated Sites Report previously known as the Affected Media and Contaminants Report. Your site will be identified as having met the compliance standards of the Model Toxics Control Act in future publications from Ecology's databases used to track contaminated sites in Washington.

This completes your review through the Ecology Voluntary Cleanup Program. Any overages in your deposit account will be forwarded to you for this site from our Fiscal Office.
