Dear Mr. Ralston:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) appreciates your decision to clean up the **Burien 76** facility (Site) independently. On July 6, 2015, we sent you a letter requesting an update on the status of your cleanup and your plan for completing the cleanup. Ecology received your response (July 28, 2015, email from Kyle Sattler to Glynis Carrosino) to our request for information.

Based on your response, which also included the following information: a June 1, 2015, report which presented the Site April 2015 monitoring and sampling results, as well as historical data; and the perspective that another report (with an anticipated submittal date to Ecology by October 2015) is currently being prepared which will include an evaluation of Site shallow ground water potability, as well as also addressing key comments provided in my July 2013 opinion letter by providing additional site maps, updated data, boring logs, cross-sections and figures to enable Ecology to better critique the proposed remedy, Ecology has agreed to continue providing you with services under the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP).

Specifically, the October 2015 characterization report will:

- Characterize of the magnitude and extent soil and groundwater, both on- and off-site;
- Comprehensively explain the shallow groundwater non-potability determination; and





- Present complete exposure pathways and appropriate MTCA cleanup levels for the established constituents of concern (COCs);
