Dear Mr. Ruf:

In June of 1997, the Industrial Section received a copy of the final remediation report and the restrictive covenant required by the consent decree, summons no. 97-2027738. The decree between the Department of Ecology and Weyerhaeuser directed Weyerhaeuser to remediate soil contamination found on the Weyerhaeuser Everett East Site and to perform ground water monitoring.

Weyerhaeuser completed the construction portion of the decree in June of 1997. A ground water monitoring plan was approved for the site in March of 1995. The filing of the deed restriction was the last unfinished requirement of the decree. With the filing, Ecology believes that Weyerhaeuser Company has satisfactorily completed the remedial actions set forth in the consent decree. The Department certifies that in our best technical judgement the property has met with all of the requirement stated in the East Site consent decree.
