Cleanup Complete! Proposed Removal from the Hazardous Sites List

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) proposes removing the Weyerhaeuser DuPont cleanup site from the Hazardous Sites List. This decision was based on a periodic review finished in early 2016.

You are invited to submit comments on proposed removal and the draft Periodic Review Report from June 9 - July 21. The box to the left shows where to find the draft Periodic Review Report.

Site Background and Cleanup

The Weyerhaeuser DuPont cleanup site is located at 2301 Center Drive and adjacent properties. It began as DuPont Works, a factory that made explosive materials. That activity contaminated the site with petroleum hydrocarbons, volatile organic compounds, metals, and solvents.

Contaminated soils were cleaned up through removal, capping, and tree root zone remediation. Afterward, groundwater was monitored to track how contaminants reduce. In addition, an environmental covenant, which restricts some types of land use, was placed on the site. The periodic review checked each of these actions to be sure they still protect human health and the environment.

What did the Review Find?

After the periodic review, Ecology determined that the cleanup was successful according to groundwater monitoring requirements and the requirements of the consent decree. The environmental covenant and a requirement for further reviews every 5 years will stay in place. What Happens Next

Your comments are invited through July 12. After the comment period, we will respond to comments. We may require further sampling or cleanup based on information given by the public. Otherwise, we will remove the site from the Hazardous Sites List.




What is the Hazardous Sites List?
