RE: Site Hazard Assessment Score Notification – Eastgate Park, Facility Site ID: 305

The Benton-Franklin Health Department (BFHD) has completed the site hazard assessment (SHA) of the Eastgate Park site as required under the Model Toxics Control Act. This site's hazard ranking, an estimation of the potential threat to human health and/or the environment relative to all other Washington State sites assessed at this time, has been determined to be a No Further Action.

For your information, Ecology will be publishing the ranking of this and other recently assessed sites in the February 25, 2003 Special Issue of the Site Register. The site hazard ranking will be used in conjunction with other site-specific considerations in determining Ecology's priority for future actions.
