



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Ecology plans to conduct an interim action at the Big B Mini Mart Site at 1611 Canyon Road in Ellensburg. An interim action is a partial cleanup designed to significantly reduce contaminants and/or exposure to contaminants. The interim action will recover diesel and gasoline liquids in the ground that pose a risk to human health and the environment.
