Dear Ms. Goschen:

Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on the K Ply Site (Site). This letter provides written notification that the Interim Action, Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS), and preliminary Draft Cleanup Action Plan (DCAP) required at the Site by Agreed Order No. DE 9546 (Order) under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW, have been satisfactorily completed. The Order became effective on October 15, 2012. This letter also describes the next steps for the Site.

Completion of Remedial Actions Required by the Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section IX (Satisfaction of Order).

The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII (Work to Be Performed). The Port of Port Angeles was required to (1) demolish mill structures and implement environmental controls during and after demolition as an Interim Action, (2) complete a RI/FS for the Site, and (3) prepare a preliminary DCAP for the Site. After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined the remedial actions in Section VII have been satisfactorily completed.

Next Steps at the Site

After review and consideration of comments received during the public comment period from April 2 to May 4, 2015, Ecology issued a final Cleanup Action Plan (CAP) on May 19, 2015.


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Ecology and the Port of Port Angeles signed Agreed Order DE 11302, effective May 19, 2015, to implement the CAP. Ecology approved the Engineering Design Report on August 19, 2015 and construction was completed May 13, 2016. The Construction Completion Report, submitted August 11, 2016, is currently under review. Ecology looks forward to continuing this working relationship under Agreed Order DE 11302.
