Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on the K Ply Site (Site). This letter provides written notification that the interim actions required at the Site by Remedial Action Order No. 90-S255 (Order) under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW, have been satisfactorily completed or are no longer necessary due to remedial actions undertaken pursuant to Agreed Order No. DE 11302. The Order became effective on October 31, 1990. This letter also describes the next steps for the Site.

Completion of Remedial Actions Required by the Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied or are no longer necessary. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section VI (Satisfaction of Order).


The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section IV (Work to Be Performed). ITT Rayonier was required to complete actions including: (1) providing documentation by a licensed professional engineer that the containment in place is adequate to prevent leakage of hydraulic oil from the plywood presses; (2) preparing an interim action plan for collection of hydraulic oil floating on the ground water table and to excavate and remove soils contaminated with pentachlorophenol (PCP); and (3) implementing the interim action plan.

Cleanup Action Plan, this does not release other potentially liable parties from responsibility under MTCA.
