Proposal to Remove Olympic Pipe Line Co Kent from the Hazardous Sites List

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is proposing to remove the Olympic Pipe Line Co. Kent (Site) from the Hazardous Sites List. The Site is located at 74th Avenue South and South 259th Street, Kent, Washington.

The Site was cleaned up under the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP). Under the VCP, responsible parties clean up contamination to meet the state cleanup standards under the Model Toxics Control Act, Washington's hazardous waste cleanup law. Ecology provides technical and regulatory review assistance through the VCP.

Ecology has determined that the cleanup work at the Site meets the requirements of state cleanup regulations. The Site was cleaned up to the point that it no longer poses a threat to human health and the environment. Ecology proposes to remove the Site from the Hazardous Sites List, which is a list of contaminated sites maintained by Ecology. The list shows sites ranked according to their level of potential hazard.

Site Background

The Site is located at 74th Ave S and S. 259th Street in Kent, WA. In 1989, a release of gasoline and diesel associated with the Olympic Pipe Line

Company (OPLC) Kent Block Valve was discovered. The groundwater contaminant plume extended from the block valve in a southwesterly direction beneath the 25618 74th Avenue South property towards the Green River. The block valve is part of an underground pipeline that supplies refined petroleum products from refineries in north Washington to bulk fuel terminals and other facilities for distribution.

Hazardous Sites List

Ecology added the property to the Hazardous Sites List in 2000. The Site underwent a Site Hazard Assessment (SHA) and was ranked a “2” under the Washington Ranking Method (WARM). The WARM ranking uses a scale of 1 to 5, where “1” represents the highest risk and “5” represents the lowest risk. This ranking estimates the potential threat to human health and the environment relative to other sites in Washington State.


What was done to clean up the site?

OPLC excavated approximately 30 cubic yards of hydrocarbon impacted soil from the area immediately surrounding the block valve. Additional soil excavations were completed from August 31 – September 27, 1989 when another 1,950 tons of soil were removed.

Approximately 168 gallons of contaminated ground water and product were pumped out and removed from the Site.

Ecology determined the Site meets state cleanup standards for soil and groundwater protective of human health and the environment. Therefore, Ecology is proposing to delist the Site from the Hazardous Sites List.




