Dear Ms. Beraza:

I'm happy to report a recent file review demonstrated the above-referenced site is eligible for a "no further action" determination.

The lead and arsenic contaminated soil from prior pesticide use is contained under a cap of clean soil, and as such, no further action is required (under the Model Toxics Control Act, chapter 70.105D RCW) to protect human health and the environment.

Ecology has received all the necessary documentation regarding the required restrictive covenant. The restrictive covenant was recorded and filed on 8/12/10 (county recording # 7700587).

Ecology has updated its database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. The school will not appear in future publications of the Confirmed & Suspected Contaminated Sites Report. Ecology has also removed the school from the Hazardous Sites List. This process included a thirty (30) day public comment period.
