In 2011, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) Toxics Cleanup Program completed a Site Hazard Assessment (SHA) for Cream Wine, located at 111 East Lincoln Avenue in Sunnyside, as required under the Model Toxics Control Act. The site's hazard ranking was published in the upcoming Special Issue of the Site Register.

Recently, Ecology determined that Cream Wine was erroneously published with a rank of 5. Ecology has re-calculated the hazard ranking for Cream Wine to be a 2.

The corrected site hazard ranking will be published in the February 2012 Special Issue of the Site Register along with other recently assessed sites.
