The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed the request that Sound Earth Strategies, Inc. (SES) submitted (letter dated April 25, 2014) requesting an extension of the schedule agreed to in Exhibit D of the Prospective Purchaser Consent Decree No. 13-2-27556-2. The SKS Shell Station Property is also known as Alaska Street Texaco.

Ecology recognizes the cleanup tasks completed to date (removal of the underground storage tanks), but is concerned that progress slowed down on this project. Ecology approves the revised schedule proposed in your letter dated April 25, 2014. In approving this revised schedule, Ecology wants to clarify that LMI West Seattle, LLC's (LMI) obligation to clean up the Site is not waived or based on LMI obtaining a Master Use Permit (MUP) from the City of Seattle.
