RESTRICTIVE COVENANT and NOTICE Intalco Triple Lined Dangerous Waste Landfill

Grantor: Intalco Aluminum Corporation

Grantee: Washington Department of Ecology

Legal Description: A tract of land located in the SE ¼ SEC 20, T39N, R1E, Willamette Meridian, Whatcom County, Washington. Additional legal descriptions can be found attached as Exhibit A & B

This Declaration of Restrictive Covenant is made under the Uniform Environmental Covenants Act (2007 Wash. Laws ch 104), RCW 70.105D.030(1)(f), RCW 70.105D.30(1)(g), WAC 173-340-440 and WAC 173-303-610 by Intalco Aluminum Corporation (hereafter "Intalco"), its successors and assigns, and the State of Washington Department of Ecology, its successors an assigns (herein after "Ecology").

RECITALS

- A. A remedial action (hereafter "Remedial Action") occurred at the property that is the subject of this Restrictive Covenant and Notice. The Remedial Action conducted at the property is described in the Consent Decree entered in the *State of Washington Department of Ecology v. Intalco*, Whatcom County Superior Court No. 07-2-00181-2 and in attachments to the Decree and in documents referenced in the Decree. These documents are on file at Ecology's Olympia Washington Office.
- B. This Restrictive Covenant is required because, after the Remedial Action is complete, the property will contain contaminated soil within a physical barrier that will prevent plants or wildlife from being exposed to the soil. See WAC 173-340-7491(1)(b). Furthermore, this Restrictive Covenant prohibits groundwater withdrawal on the site due to the presence of contaminates of concern in the groundwater.

- C. The property that is the subject of this Restrictive Covenant and Notice has been used to manage dangerous waste within a permitted dangerous waste disposal unit. The owner or operator of a dangerous waste disposal unit is obligated to provide notice and restrict disturbance of the dangerous waste disposal site in accordance with the applicable requirements of WAC 173-303-610 and 40 CFR 265 Subpart G.
- D. The undersigned, Intalco, is the fee owner of the real property (hereafter "Property") located in the County of Whatcom, State of Washington, and more particularly described in Exhibit A attached to this Covenant.
- E. Within the Property is located a parcel of land that is the subject of this Restrictive Covenant and Notice (the "Restricted Site").
- F. The Restricted Site, known as the Triple Lined Dangerous Waste Landfill is more particularly described in Exhibit B attached to this Restrictive Covenant and Notice.
- G. The restrictions and covenants agreed to and the Notice given under this Restrictive Covenant and Notice apply solely to the Restricted Site and do not apply in any way to the remainder of the Property.

DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS AND COVENANTS

Intalco makes the following declaration as to limitations, restrictions, and uses to which the Restricted Site may be put and specifies that such declarations shall constitute covenants to run with the land, as provided by law and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them, including all current and future owners of any portion of or interest in the Restricted Site (hereafter "Owner").

- Section 1. The Restricted Site contains dangerous wastes which contain PAH's, PCBs, fluoride, cyanide and metals. The Restricted Site is capped to prevent human, plant or wildlife exposure to the dangerous waste. The owner shall not alter, modify, or remove the existing structure in any manner that may result in the release or exposure to the environment of that dangerous waste or create a new exposure pathway without prior written approval from Ecology. Any activity on the Restricted Site that may result in the release or exposure to the environment of the dangerous waste that was contained as part of the Remedial Action, or create a new exposure pathway, is prohibited. Some examples of activities that are prohibited in the Restricted Site include: drilling, digging, placement of any objects or use of any equipment which deforms or stresses the surface beyond its load bearing capability, piercing the surface with a rod, spike or similar item, bulldozing or earthwork.
- Section 2: Withdrawal of groundwater at the Restricted Site is prohibited.
- Section 3. Any activity on the Restricted Site that may interfere with the integrity of the Remedial Action and continued protection of human health and the environment is prohibited.

- <u>Section 4.</u> Any activity on the Restricted Site that may result in the release or exposure to the environment of a hazardous substance that remains on the Restricted Site as part of the Remedial Action, or create a new exposure pathway, is prohibited without prior written approval from Ecology.
- Section 5. The Owner of the Restricted Site, or any portion thereof, must give fifteen (15) days advance written notice to Ecology of the Owner's intent to convey any interest in the Restricted Site or said portion thereof. No conveyance of title, easement, lease, or other interest in the Restricted Site shall be consummated by the Owner without adequate and complete provision for continued monitoring, operation, and maintenance of the Remedial Action in accordance with the Consent Decree and Cleanup Action Plan.
- Section 6. The Owner must restrict leases to uses and activities consistent with the Restrictive Covenant and notify all lessees of the restrictions on the use of the Restricted Site. The Owner must include in any instrument conveying any interest in any portion of the Restricted Site, notice of this Restrictive Covenant.
- Section 7. The Owner must notify and obtain approval from Ecology prior to any use of the Restricted Site that is inconsistent with the terms of this Covenant. Ecology may approve any inconsistent use only after public notice and comment. If Ecology approves of an inconsistent use, this Restrictive Covenant must be amended to reflect the change.
- Section 8. The Owner shall allow authorized representatives of Ecology the right to enter the Restricted Site at reasonable times for the purpose of evaluating the Remedial Action; to take samples, to inspect remedial actions conducted at the Restricted Site, to determine compliance with this Restrictive Covenant, and to inspect records that are related to the Remedial Action.
- <u>Section 9.</u> If the conditions at the Restricted Site which requires a restrictive covenant no longer exist, the Owner may submit a request to Ecology that this Restrictive Covenant be removed. This Restrictive Covenant shall be removed only if Ecology, after public notice and comment, concurs.

NOTICE

Intalco Aluminum Corporation hereby gives notice that pursuant to regulations of the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, WAC 173-303-610(10), the property herein described has been used to manage dangerous waste as identified by the Washington State Department of Ecology in WAC 173-303-070 through 173-303-103. Accordingly, use of the property is restricted under WAC 173-303-610(7)(d). A survey plat and record of the type, location, and quantity of dangerous waste disposed of within the area of the waste management unit, as required by WAC 173-303-610(9), has been filed with the Whatcom County Auditor's Office, the Whatcom County Health Dept and the Washington State Department of Ecology and is shown in Exhibit B.






