Dear Ms. Thompson,

The Olympic Region Clean Air Agency (ORCAA) learned of your independent cleanup of the Mason County Transportation Cooperative facility located at 3740 Shelton Springs Rd, Shelton, WA. As stated by Alfredo Arroyo in the letter mailed to you on March 8th, 2016, **installing or establishing a stationary remediation system that results in volatizing any detectable dissolved hydrocarbons to the outdoor atmosphere requires permitting with ORCAA beforehand.** This is a requirement of ORCAA's Rule 6.1 enforced with the authority of Chapter 70.94 of the Revised Code of Washington State, unless exempted by the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

I want to check on the status of the soil remediation project and inquire on how the site is being cleaned up.

Using equipment with aeration, air stripping, air sparging, or soil vapor extraction technologies will result in volatizing dissolved hydrocarbons, and thus result in increases of outdoor air pollution. See the attachments for more information on the technologies.

If you intend to install equipment using any of the technologies mentioned in this letter, a permit with ORCAA is required prior to installation. If the remediation action has already been completed, please contact ORCAA so we can update our files.
