Dear Mr. Carlson:

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received the reports for Unocal #4511, submitted by EMCON Northwest, Inc., dated September 5, 1990 and May 21, 1992.

Based on a review of these reports, this site has been given a final cleanup status of "no further action" or completed. The information provided to Ecology regarding the investigation and cleanup conducted, appears to have followed the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) regulation Chapter 173-340-450 WAC relating to releases from underground storage tanks.


The investigation and cleanup at this site is considered an Independent Cleanup Action under the MTCA, and was done at the potentially liable person's own risk. If an investigation is conducted in the future, and new information and analysis show contamination, the cleanup status will become active again.

This letter is not an approval of the investigation and cleanup at the site. Any comments Ecology makes on sites being cleaned up without an order or decree (independent cleanup action) are merely advisory and nonbinding, and it does not constitute an approval of a specific remedial action.
