The Department of Ecology (Ecology) appreciates you taking the time to comment on the proposal to remove the Olympic Pipeline Kent Block Valve cleanup Site from the Hazardous Sites List.

From December 2, 2016 through January 3, 2017, Ecology held the Public Comment period for delisting the Site from the Hazardous Sites List. Ecology received your comment on November 23, 2016. The No Further Action letter for the Olympic Pipe Line Co Kent site was finalized on January 17, 2017.

You expressed a concern about raw sewage in your neighborhood coming out of man holes. Ecology referred your voice message and concern to the City of Kent, Public Works Department to follow-up with you.
