Please accept this corrected correspondence as the official notice of Department of Ecology's (Ecology) determination of your status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for the Interstate 82 Exit 33A Yakima City Landfill Site (Site). There was an error in the correspondence sent, just yesterday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, as it was addressed to Mr. Wright.

On March 30, 2017, Ecology sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a PLP for a release of hazardous substances at the Site.

The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on April 30, 2017.

We received comments from you on May 2, 2017. Your comments were evaluated. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at the Site. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that the City of Yakima is a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to the Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager, Chris Wend, will continue to be in contact as we move forward.
