In keeping with the requirement of WAC 173-340-310 (5) Ecology recommends: No Further Action, because a release of a hazardous substance has occurred but in the department's judgment, does not pose a threat to human health or the environment due to removal of the contaminated soils.

Supporting Criteria:

The spill on May 19, 2016 resulted from an accident which released an unknown amount of diesel fuel at the site. On September 12, 2016 soil was removed down 9 to 12 feet. 113.62 tons were removed and disposed at the Cemex Landfill in Everett, WA. Nine confirmatory samples were taken from the bottom and walls of the excavation and analyzed using NWTPH-Dx for diesel range organics (DRO) and lube oil range organics. All results were Not Detected except one DRO result of 101 mg/kg in the south wall at 9 feet below ground surface. The Method A cleanup level for DRO is 2000 mg/kg so all samples were found to be below MTCA cleanup levels.

The excavation was filled and compacted to DOT specifications with clean fill material. The final report from LMH Environmental, Inc. is dated December 1, 2016 and was received at CRO on March 27, 2017.

This Department Decision Recommendation should be reviewed and re-evaluated based on any new information about this site.
