On behalf of the Port of Seattle (Port), this Monthly Progress Report provides a summary of all activities conducted during the month of May 2017 for the Lora Lake Apartments Site (Site) in Burien, Washington. Work is being performed pursuant to the requirements of the September 9, 2015, Consent Decree No. 15-2-21413-6 (CD) between the Port and the Washington State Department of Ecology (WSDOE). This report is organized to include all requirements listed in Section XI of the CD.

ON-SITE ACTIVITIES THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE DURING THE MONTH—SECTION XI(A)

- Ongoing Contractor development of pre-construction submittals for remedial construction actions at the Site.
- The Contractor conducted the following actions under Partial Notice to Proceed in May 2017:
 - Completed mobilization and water treatment system installation at the Dredged Material Containment Area.
 - Completed tree cutting, constructed access road through the Red Apple site, and began installation of temporary erosion and sediment controls at the Lora Lake Apartments.
 - Began installation of the silt fence and the temporary construction lake access road occurred at Lora Lake.
- Award of Contractor Full Notice to Proceed is expected in June 2017.
