Description of proposal:

Phase I will involve the excavation of approximately 360 cubic yards of an existing stockpile of mixed waste include aluminum sulfate, aluminum dross, and mineral oxides. Excavated material will be transported on-site and loaded into rail cars for shipment off-site. If successful, Phase II will involve the complete excavation of all on-site wastes into rail cars for off-site shipment.


This determination is based on the following findings and conclusions:
