Re: Reserve Silica Corporation Property

Dear Mr. Sanders:

In 2016, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) completed a Site Hazard Assessment (SHA) of the Reserve Silica Corporation property located adjacent to your property at 28750 Black Diamond-Ravensdale Road SE in Ravensdale, WA. The SHA identified evidence that a release of hazardous substances has occurred on the Reserve Silica Corporation property. The release, resulting from leachate seeping from a fill area containing cement kiln dust, has affected surface water and groundwater on your property.

Ecology has determined that Reserve Silica Corporation and Holcim (US) Inc. are Potentially Liable Parties (PLPs). We will seek to enter into an agreed order with the PLPs for investigation and cleanup of the site. Ecology has not identified you as a PLP at this time.
