Announcing a Public Meeting

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) will be holding a public meeting concerning the Everett Landfill/Tire Fire Site in Everett, Washington. This public meeting was requested by members of the Everett community.

Ecology provided a comment period from February 15 through March 19, 1990, so that members of the public could review and comment on documents relevant to the Everett Landfill/Tire Fire Site. Ecology invited the public to review and comment on the consent order, the proposed workplan that will guide the investigation, the fact sheet, and the public participation plan.

During the public comment period, over 10 individuals requested a public meeting. Under state law, Ecology is required to hold a meeting if this condition is met.

What will the Public Meeting Address?

Ecology and the City of Everett are proposing an agreement to investigate the presence of hazardous substances at the Everett Landfill/Tire Fire Site, 2902 36th Street SE, Everett, Washington. The agreement, also called a Remedial Action Order on Consent, is a legal document that defines the scope of the investigation to be

performed and the responsibilities of all the parties involved.

At the public meeting, Ecology and the City of Everett will provide information on plans for the remedial investigation, and address concerns expressed by members of the Everett community during the public comment period. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions, and make comments on the proposed workplan that will guide the investigation.
