The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your October 30, 2017 Addendum to Sampling and Analysis Work Plan (Revised Addendum) for the Woodworth Lakeview Facility, located at 2800 104<sup>th</sup> Street Court South in Tacoma, Washington (the Site). The Revised Addendum was prepared by Farallon Consulting, Inc. (Farallon) on behalf of Woodworth Capital, Inc. (Woodworth) in response to Ecology's comments, presented in a letter dated October 12, 2017 and subsequent email dated November 2, 2017, on the September 25, 2017 Sampling and Analysis Work Plan (Work Plan).

Ecology concurs with the proposed locations, methods, and procedures described in the Work Plan and associated Revised Addendum, noting that actual locations may be revised based on encountered field conditions.

<u>Please submit a Report of Findings upon completion of the proposed field activities, which includes copies of all relevant field sampling forms, boring logs, and analytical laboratory data reports. This report should include a summary of findings, discussion of potential data gaps, if present, and figures depicting monitoring wells, boring locations, groundwater gradients, and contaminant concentrations.</u>
