Dear Mr. Cach:

Washington Department of Ecology's (Ecology) Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the above described facility/property:

1. <u>Cleanup and Site Assessment Report for Coleman Oil regarding a diesel spill located at the Coleman Oil Company in Quincy, WA,</u> Able Clean-up Technologies, Inc., November 27, 2017

Based upon the above-listed information, Ecology has determined that the release(s) of *petroleum hydrocarbons into soil* does not pose a substantial threat to human health or the environment. Therefore, Ecology is issuing a NFA determination under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA)¹.

This NFA determination is made only for releases indentified in the independent remedial action report(s) listed above and applies only to the area(s) of the property affected by those releases. The NFA does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by Coleman Oil, LLC.

Because your actions were not conducted under a consent decree this letter is offered as informal assistance and advice² and does not constitute a MTCA settlement³, therefore this
