Subject: Providing Copies of Agreed Order to Contractors

In accordance with Section III Parties Bound of Agreed Order No. DE 8462, Waste Management, Inc. shall provide a copy of the Order to all agents, contractors, and subcontractors retained to perform work required by the Agreed Order, except for work activities that Ecology and Waste Management agree are routine maintenance activities.

On July 15, 2011, Ecology received from Waste Management the following list of work activities that identifies those considered routine and, therefore, not requiring Waste Management to provide the contractor a copy of the Agreed Order (AO).
