SUBJECT: Enforcement Order Docket Number DE 92TC-C108

The purpose of the aforementioned Enforcement Order was to implement an interim action to disperse bottled water to those within the Yakima Railroad Area. The Yakima Railroad Area Bottled Water program started in February of 1992, and ran through September 1995. The State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) considers this Enforcement Order and all amendments to this order complete.

The Paxton Sales site file contains documentation indicating that the bottled water program ended in September 1995. First, a letter to Mr. Eric Egbers of Cameron-Yakima dated July 23, 1996, states the program ran from 1992 to 1995. Second, the last bill received from Independent Water was for the month of September 1995. Third, Ecology settled liability with Paxton Sales (the coordinating entity of the bottled water program) in September of 1996.
