On or before March 27, 2002, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person for a release of hazardous substances at the Chelan Service Station #9-6590. The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice, and any subsequent extension granted by Ecology, has expired.

We have received your letter dated April 24, 2002, in which Chevron Products Company accepts the status as a potentially liable person for a release at the Chevron Service Station #9-6590. On the basis of this statement, the Department of Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to this site.
