On December 5, 2006, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the following site:

The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on January 12, 2006.

We have not received comments from you as of January 18, 2006. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at Unocal Bulk Plant 0601. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to Unocal Bulk Plant 0601.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility [Lisa Pearson, P.E.] will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
