Classification of Dredge Spoils


Dear Mr. Otto:

We have reviewed the test data for the dredge spoils which are presently stored on City Light property. We concur with the determination that the material is not classified as a dangerous waste. However, this does not preclude the possibility that the material may become a regulated dangerous waste due to changes in state or federal law.

In light of the available data, I am rescinding the requirement that the dredged material be capped with an impervious layer.
