JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW Plaintiff, the State of Washington, Department of Ecology (Ecology), and through its attorney, Andrew A. Fitz, Senior Counsel, and Defendants, Pete Endsley, John Endsley, by and through their attorney, Peter E. Hapke, of Hapke Law Office PLLC, jointly move the Court to dismiss this action. This action involved the implementation of a Consent Decree originally entered by the Court in this matter on August 17, 1990 (Decree), which was superseded by a Second Amended Consent Decree entered on August 2, 2010. The Decree governed remedial action at the County Junction Store Site generally located at 5310 Highway 160, in Port Orchard, Washington, at the southwest corner of S.E. Mile Hill Lane and Long Lake Road S.E., pursuant to Washington State's Model Toxics Control Act, Chapter 70.105D. Ecology has completed the remedial actions described in Tasks 1-7 in Section VI.A of the Decree (Work to be Performed), and the Defendants have satisfied the obligation described in the Section VI.B of the Decree. In compliance with the requirement of

1 Section XVII (Duration of Decree), Ecology has provided Defendants with written notification  
2 of that determination. *See Exhibit A.*

3 Both parties' obligations under the Decree having been completed, the parties therefore  
4 stipulate to dismissal of this action and seek an Order of Dismissal from the Court pursuant to  
5 Section XVII (Duration of Decree). The parties recognize and intend that dismissal of this  
6 action shall not alter the binding effect of any and all continuing rights and duties of the parties  
7 under the Decree, including but not limited to the provisions of: Section IX (Retention of  
8 Records); Section XIII (Covenant Not to Sue); Section XIV (Contribution Protection); Section  
9 XV (Indemnification); and Section XVIII (Claims Against the State).


10 Therefore, the parties now move for dismissal of this action with prejudice and without

Thank you for working with the Department of Ecology (Ecology) and for your efforts to help clean up the above mentioned Site.

This letter is provided pursuant to Section XVII of the Second Amended Consent Decree in *State of Washington, Department of Ecology v. Pete Endsley and John Endsley*, Kitsap County Superior Court No. 90-2-01914-6; entered August 2, 2010. As provided in that section, Ecology confirms that on December 6, 2017, you submitted all required reimbursement under Section VI.B of the Decree (as amended by letter agreement of the parties on December 19, 2016), and have satisfactorily completed those obligations of the Decree.

With your obligations satisfied, and Ecology having satisfied Tasks 1-7 of Decree Section VI.A, the Attorney General's Office will work with your attorney to dismiss the Consent Decree. The Second Amended Consent Decree outlined a number of actions for Ecology to undertake that, while substantial, constituted interim actions under the Model Toxics Control Act. A final cleanup action has not yet been implemented at the Country Junction Store Site. However, your obligations under the Model Toxics Control Act, have been resolved.

Again, thank you for working with Ecology to clean up the contamination at this Site.
