The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed the scope of work for the supplemental site investigation work as part of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) for the former Chevron Pipeline Company Site (Site) at the Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company (Tesoro) facility in Pasco, Franklin County, WA. The reviewed scope of work is outlined in a letter dated December 10, 2017, from CEECON Testing Inc. (CEECON).

Additionally, Ecology has also reviewed a revision to the supplemental RI/FS site investigation work; this revision is described in a letter from CEECON, dated April 12, 2018.

Ecology concurs with the revised scope of work described in the two letters prepared by CEECON and you may implement the supplemental RI/FS Site investigation as soon as possible.
