

## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Descri	ption of Proposal:	Spokane River Metals Remediation Project: Islands Lagoon. The primary goal of this project is isolation of contaminants. An approximate 1 foot thickness of gravel cover will be constructed over approximately ¼ acre of the shoreline. A 1/3 <sup>rd</sup> foot thick layer of filter rock will be incorporated into the lower portion of the cover to prevent loss of underlying fine-grained sediment. A line of boulders will be anchored along, and incorporated into, this face to prevent on-going erosion and to increase recreational user safety.

Location of Proposal:		South side of Spokane River near S. Wellesley Ave and N. Evergreen Rd. Spokane Valley, WA
