

WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY SEPA NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS) NORTH MARKET STREET SITE

The Washington Department of Ecology is issuing a determination of non-significance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA, Chapter 197-11 WAC) Rules. This DNS is being issued for the North Market Street site located in the Hillyard area, one mile north of the City of Spokane corporate limits, Spokane County, Washington. After review of the completed environmental checklist and other site specific information on file with Ecology, Ecology has determined that the Cleanup Action Plan for remediation of petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals in soil and groundwater at the site will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
