DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal *Play areas at Progress Elementary (5.5 acres) were found to have soil contaminated with moderate levels of lead and arsenic at a depth not exceeding 18". Contaminated soils will be covered with a geotextile membrane and 6" of clean topsoil. Clean topsoil will then be graded and revegetated to pre-existing conditions.*
