Dear Mr. Glick:

Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on the Whitney's Chevrolet (Site). This letter provides written notification that the Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, Interim Actions, and Draft Cleanup Action Plan (CAP) required at the Site by Agreed Order No. 2951 (Order) under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW, have been satisfactorily completed. The Order became effective on May 30, 2007 and was superseded by Agreed Order No. 11121 for Implementation of CAP, which became effective June 25, 2015. This letter also describes the next steps for the Site.

Completion of Remedial Actions Required by the Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the original Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section IX (Satisfaction of Order).

The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII (Work to Be Performed). Whitney's Chevrolet was required to provide work plans for RI/FS, provide work plans for any anticipated interim actions, perform and provide reports for RI/FS and any interim actions performed, and provide a Draft CAP for finalization by Ecology. After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined the remedial actions in Section VII have been satisfactorily completed.

Next Steps at the Site

Ecology has completed a Draft Cleanup Action Plan (DCAP) for the Site. After review and consideration of comments received during the public comment period and publication of a Responsiveness Summary, Ecology issued a final Cleanup Action Plan (CAP) which became effective June 25, 2015.

The CAP will be implemented in Agreed Order No. DE 11121. Negotiations for the agreed order have been completed, and Ecology looks forward to continuing this working relationship.
