Dear Ms. Bardy:

Antea Group is providing notice, under the terms of the Technical Assistance Agreement (TAAG) between the Department of Ecology and Antea Group, to terminate our participation in the TAAG with Ecology's Northwest Region. We have determined that transferring the sites still currently in the TAAG program to the recently created Petroleum Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) will better align with our cleanup project closure goals and timelines. A list of the current TAAG sites to be transferred is provided on the attached Table 1.

Antea Group met with the Pollution Liability Insurance Agency (PLIA) to discuss the logistics of transferring these projects into the PTAP. The sites will be charged the standard fee that any new site would pay to enter into PTAP. The tasks described under the TAAG Project Term and Agreement of Termination Section 10(d) that allows Ecology to prepare final summary reports for every remaining TAAG site at Antea Group's expense will not be needed to facilitate the transfer into PTAP. Since we intend to move forward with this transition to PTAP immediately, we request that Ecology not incur these unnecessary costs.
