DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).

Description of proposal: BNSF Railway Company and Husky Oil Operations Limited and Washington Department of Ecology entered into Agreed Order (AO) No. 9188 on 6 August 2012 to complete a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study for contamination related to historical activities at the Site. The AO is being amended to conduct an Interim Action at the Site to remove soils that were previously contaminated by historical releases of diesel and Bunker C fuel. Approximately 11,460 square feet of the Site will be excavated to depths up to 15 feet below ground surface (bgs) using conventional excavation methods. Prior to beginning excavation, approximately 1,800 linear feet of known underground piping and infrastructure remaining within the Site boundaries will be removed and disposed at an off-Site landfill. Some of the underground piping is wrapped with asbestos-containing material that will be removed, bagged, and disposed of at an appropriate landfill in accordance with Spokane County Clean Air Agency regulations. Excavated soils will be transported via truck and trailer or rail to an approved landfill for disposal. All excavations will be backfilled with clean fill to their original grade and appropriately compacted. Backfill material and compaction shall comply with specifications provided by WSDOT and BNSF.
