Public comment invited

Ecology will enter into a legal agreement called an Agreed Order with Potentially Liable Persons (PLPs): Chevron Environmental Management Company and Strickland Real Estate Holdings LLC.

The Agreed Order requires the PLPs to conduct a Remedial Investigation (RI) and Feasibility Study (FS) and prepare a Draft Cleanup Action Plan (DCAP). They will prepare an RI/FS Report describing the investigation of contamination at the Site and evaluating cleanup alternatives. The DCAP describes how selected cleanup alternative will be performed.

We invite you to review and comment on the following documents:

- Draft Agreed Order
- Draft Public Participation Plan

The Public Participation Plan describes how Ecology will inform the community about Site activities and opportunities to become involved in the cleanup process.

Background

Contamination came from a former service station and lube facility. A gasoline service station operated on the Site from 1959 until 1974. In 1977 a lube facility began operations on the Site. In 1995, a number of underground storage tanks containing petroleum products were closed in place, and one was removed. Jiffy Lube took over operations from 2004 until 2006 when the facility closed. Aloha Café currently operates a coffee shop on the property.

Chemicals of Concern

Petroleum products (Gasoline, Diesel, Oil-range Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons), Benzene, Toluene, Ethyl-Benzene, and Xylene (BTEX) in soil and groundwater. Naphthalene in soil only.

What Happens Next?

If no significant changes are made, the documents will be finalized and RI work will begin in fall 2018. The next opportunity for public comment is expected to be when the DCAP is complete in summer 2019.
