RE: Determination of Potentially Liable Person Status

Dear Mr. Phillips

On June 19, 2007 the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the following site:

• Name: Denny Way Combined Sewer Overflow Site

• Address: 3165 Alaskan Way, Seattle, Washington

• Facility No.: 4455938

In your letter dated June 22, 2007 to Ecology, you informed Ecology that King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks (NRP) has decided to waive the right to the thirty (30)-day notice and comment period described in WAC 173-340-500(3) and accepted the status of NRP as a Potential Liable Person at the above referenced site

Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at the County's Denny Way Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) facility. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to the CSO site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, Grant Yang, will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
