The Department of Ecology (Ecology) appreciates your decision to clean up the Titus Will Enterprises, Inc. (a.k.a. Tam Engineering Corporation) facility (Site) independently. However, our records indicate that you have not conducted any remedial actions for some time. This letter requests information on the status of your cleanup and your continued interest in the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP).

## **Request for Information**

Please provide the following requested information to Ecology by February 15 2019:

1. **Plan and schedule for completing the cleanup.** Please provide a cleanup action plan providing sufficient information for Ecology to determine that it is likely that the Site will be cleaned up in a reasonable timeframe.
2. **Required electronic data.** Please ensure that all environmental Site data collected since August 1, 2005, are accepted into Ecology's Environmental Information Management (EIM) system database. Ecology's current data submittal requirements are provided in Toxic Cleanup Program Policy 840, available at the following location:

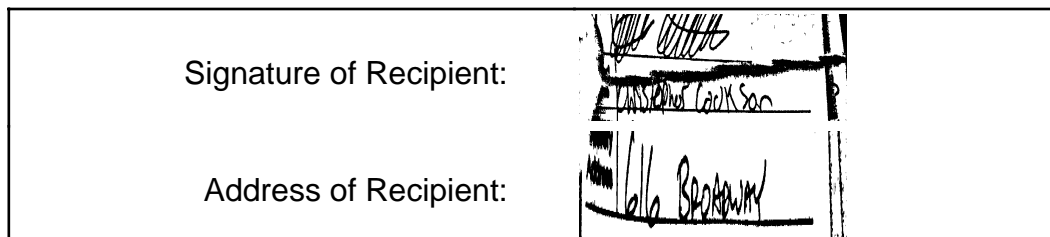
