Dear Ms. Wecker,

The above referenced site has been listed in the Washington State Department of Ecology (“Ecology”) Confirmed and Suspected Contaminated Site List (“CSCSL”) after an Initial Investigation was conducted on March 4, 2009 by the Tacoma Pierce County Health Department (“TPCHD”) in response to an anonymous complaint of signs of soil contamination. The TPCHD identified three areas at the site that may contain petroleum-impacted soil. The potential release was listed under Environmental Response Tracking System (“ERTS”) 610861.

Aerotech Environmental Consulting, Inc. (“Aerotech”) is submitting the attached Phase II Limited & Targeted Subsurface Investigation to demonstrate that current site conditions, when compared to the compliance regulations outlined in the Model Toxics Control Act (“MTCA”), as established by Ecology in Chapter 173-340 of the Washington Administrative Code (“WAC”) and implemented under RCW Chapter 70.105D, are not evident of a contaminant release at the Site.

Based on these conditions, Aerotech is requesting the removal of the Site from the CSCSL along with confirmation of the closure of the potential release listed under ERTS 610861.
