As manager of state-owned aquatic lands, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is submitting this release report in accordance with WAC 173-340-300(2)(a). Sediment sampling was performed by lessee and dredging applicant, Harbour Village Marina, in accordance with the requirements of the Dredge Materials Management Program (DMMP). Results identified chemicals in the sediment that may pose a threat to human health and the environment based on DMMP open water disposal and sediment management standards.

The report from Associated Earth Sciences, Inc., conveys all information about the sampling of which DNR is aware. The site is located at 6155 NE 175th St, Kenmore, WA 98028-4804, Latitude 47.75728, Longitude -122.2607. The site was previously assigned Ecology Facility/Site No. 43784654. Harbour Village Marina is under a DNR managed lease for use of the aquatic land. The site is currently used for a 135 slip condominium moorage facility. The DNR currently has no knowledge of the origin of the detected chemicals.

DNR has been advised by Ecology that all cleanup aspects of the dredging, including any MTCA requirements that may apply to DNR, are being satisfied and overseen by Ecology via their DMMP representation. Work approved through DMMP is not a DNR cleanup action and the effectiveness and results are the responsibility of the dredging proponent and lessee. As land manager, DNR awaits Ecology's recommended direction on this matter and will continue to coordinate with our lessee, Harbour Village Marina.
