WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Covering the NE Corner of Gas Works Park with a 12 inch layer of soil and reseed with grass. This project will prevent the migration of PAH containing soil to the sediments of Lake Union. It will also increase the separation of park users from PAH contamination.

Proponent: Washington State Department of Ecology, Toxics Cleanup Program (TCP)

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The City of Seattle's Gas Works Park, located at 2101 North Northlake Way, Seattle WA 98103

Lead agency: Washington State Department of Ecology, Toxics Cleanup Program (TCP)
