The Department of Ecology (Ecology) is terminating the VCP Agreement governing Project No. CE0309. The project involved the cleanup of the Simplot Soilbuilders Sunnyside facility (Site). The effective date of termination is the date of this letter. We are providing this notice in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

Reason

Ecology is terminating the Agreement because you informed us by letter on January 22, 2019, that you wanted to withdraw from the VCP and proceed under an Agreed Order at the Site.

1. Send you an invoice for any costs remaining on your account. In accordance with the terms of the Agreement, you remain responsible for any costs incurred by us before the effective date of termination.
2. Initiate discussions for an agreed order or consent decree that will govern further action at the Site.


