Mr. Norm Hepner:

3 Kings Environmental Inc. (3 Kings) is pleased to submit this Addendum to the Site Closure Report for the Ryder Truck Rental, Inc. facility in Yakima, Washington. The report documents the past site activities including the last four (4) groundwater monitoring events to comply with the State of Washington Department of Ecology guidelines for site closure with groundwater contamination. This addendum addresses irregularities discovered in the 4th quarter 2010 analytical data set that could affect the request for an NFA for the Site.

LABORATORY ANALYTICAL RESULTS

In the 4th Quarter 2010 Groundwater Sampling Report sample RW-1-103010 was reported as non-detect for diesel. However, reviewing the laboratory data the diesel concentration in this sample was reported as 0.528 mg/l and was incorrectly interpreted and recorded by the previous preparer. The actual laboratory reported concentration for diesel should read 528 ug/l. This value has been corrected and added to the most recent groundwater data tables presented in the site closure report.

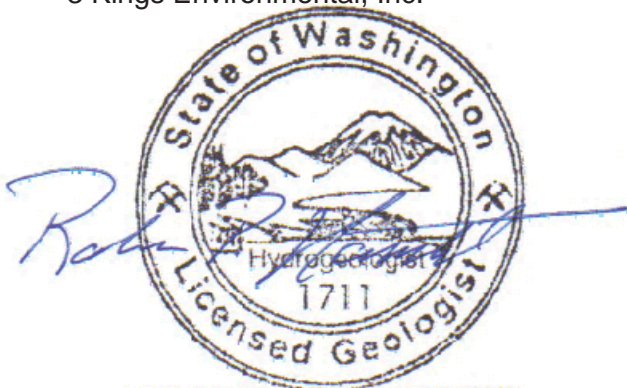
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In a discussion with the laboratory the old data indicated very old diesel with the possibility of biogenic interference. There is also the possibility of the laboratory inadvertently contaminated the sample.

If the diesel result of 528 ug/l is correct, the sample was only over the cleanup level of 500 ug/l by 28 ug/l and with the following three (3) sampling results reporting non-detect for diesel, it is 3 Kings' Opinion that the groundwater at well RW-1 has met the groundwater cleanup criteria for MTCA and requests a 'No Further Action' determination.
