Thank you for submitting the Cascade Natural Gas Vapor Intrusion Sampling Results. Ecology agrees with your consultant's assessment that the data do not indicate a vapor intrusion (VI) risk at the CNG Building **under the existing conditions**. However, if conditions at the building should change for any reason, Ecology expects that the VI risk be assessed again, and if necessary, vapor mitigation risk measures such as installation of a sub-slab depressurization system be performed.
